## Tobacco Farm Life Museum's "Stepping into the Past" Saturday Event Series

Thank you for signing up to participate in the 2017 "301 Endless Yard Sale." This year's event will take place on June 16<sup>th</sup> & 17<sup>th</sup>. We look forward to your participation and invite you to participate in additional activities on the grounds throughout the year. The Museum is a non-profit 501c3 organization that relies on donations and admissions to remain open. Our mission is to "Preserve and Present the History and Heritage of the rural farming family in North Carolina". We fulfill this mission by exhibiting tools and buildings that represent the traditional lifestyle of the rural farming community. In addition we offer guided and non-guided tours and open our grounds each Saturday to demonstrators of traditional crafts and trades. As a participant in the yard sale we are asking that a \$25 donation per 10' x 20' spot per day be provided at least two weeks in advance to reserve your spot. Spaces are limited so sign up early.

Please review the guidelines below and return the signed sheet with your reservations fee to the Museum Staff by Friday, June 2, 2016.

### Considerations for Demonstrating/Setting up on the grounds:

1. Vendors need to bring their own chairs, tables and complete set-up.
2. Set-up is to be done no earlier than 6am and no later than 7am, and clean up/tear down completed by 6pm each day. Vendors are welcome to camp out on-site with advanced notice. The Museum and its staff and or Board of Directors will not be responsible for any items left on-site unattended.
3. Please register with staff prior to setting up and tearing down.
4. Vendors/Demonstrators are responsible for picking up ALL unsold merchandise or demonstration materials. Should items be lost, stolen or damaged, the Tobacco Farm Life Museum is not responsible for compensating the vendor/demonstrator for the items.
5. Setup and tear down will need to be done while staff is on the premises unless otherwise agreed upon.
6. We cannot guarantee audience numbers.
7. Photos will be taken during the events for promotional and programming purposes. In signing the registration form, you give the Tobacco Farm Life Museum permission to take your photo/record your activities onsite.
8. Breakfast, Lunch, and dinner will not be provided. We ask that vendors provide their own lunch, snacks and drinks. There are several restaurants within a mile from the Museum. The Museum will be selling snacks, hotdogs, chips and drinks during the event.
9. Pets are prohibited in the buildings, if they are on the grounds they must be up to date on their shots, remain on leashes at all times and prior approval must be made by staff.
10. Please feel free to bring assistants with you during the event; children 16 and under must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
11. The Staff will assign set up locations. Please check in with a staff member prior to setting up.
